- 16 Lincoln Elementary, where Baby Jane transferred after the move from South Emporia to E. 5th.
- 17 Jefferson Elementary, where Noel attended when he moved to Eldora from Seattle in 1947.
- 21 Train station (one of two in the town).
- 22 Plaza Apartments & Hotel, where Mr. Hester resided when he met Sim and Ray in 1943 and gave the bone necklace to Sim.
- 23 Montgomery Ward store.
- 24 J. C. Penney store.
- 25 McClelland's 5 & 10 store; Farlo Nemic's law office on 2nd Floor.
- 26 Classen's Haberdashery, where Mr. Nemic took Cimarron shopping for his Miami Beach choir trip.
- 27 Butler County courthouse with sheriff's office and City/County jail in basement.
- 28 First Baptist Church, where Vida & children worshipped; Socony Vacuum service station across street.
- 29 Carnegie Library, where Sim occasionally went for reading.
- 30 Cimarron's best friend Noel Osborne's house, corner of West Taylor Avenue and South Topeka Street.
- 31 Municipal pool and park.
- 32 Hospital.
- 33 Junior High building; grades 7 through 9.
- 34 Senior High building; grades 10 through 12.
- 35 Hole in the Wall drugstore & fountain, where Sim and Noel went for refreshments & magazine reading.
- 36 Liege Theater; Eldora kids went there for Saturday matinees, westerns and serials like Hopalong Cassidy and Sky King.
- 37 Graham's Drug Store and soda fountain at Main and Central.
- 38 First National Bank, owned by Mr. Gaines, father of Phyllis who was Sim's nemesis at Washington Elementary.
- 39 Landsdowne's Diner, home of the world's best Veal burger.
- 40 Western Auto store.
- 41 Roxy Theater (one of three in the town).
- 42 Marlina Zoellner's house, Sim's sometimes girlfriend.
- 43 Cimarron's shack on E. 5th; McNeills moved to the abandoned hovel when landlord Swindoll evicted them from the South Emporia Street home the day of the funeral.
- 44 Daryl's Drug Store; Daryl built and furnished it himself with G. I. loans after getting a pharmacy degree with G. I. benefits. Kids from the North Main neighborhood frequented the place for jukebox music and cokes after school and on weekends.
- 45 New Safeway store. Affordable eats for the McNeills!
- 48 Ravine behind McNeills' E. 5th Avenue shack.
